Students aged 6 to 10 entering 1st through 6th grade are invited to attend.

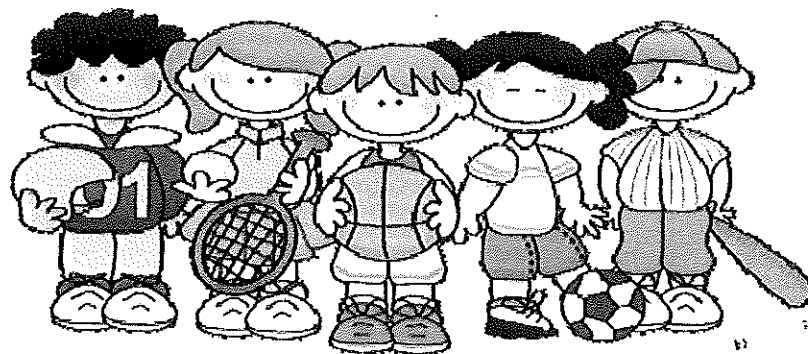
Participants must reside within the town of Westerlo,

Any necessary forms are available at the town building prior to opening day of the program; or can be filled out at the park on the first day. They must be handed in to our certified nurse. Thanks in advance for your cooperation and support. It is sincerely hoped that your child will enjoy the program.

General Information

The program will be held for one week, July 30th through August 3rd, at the Westerlo Town Park. Children entering 1st through 6th grade, who reside within the Town of Westerlo (including Dormansville and South Westerlo) are eligible to attend.

The program begins at 9:00 am and ends promptly at 12 noon. Drop-off time begins at 8:45 a.m. Please be especially cautious while dropping and picking up your child.

If there is heavy rain, the program will be cancelled for that day. If it is raining lightly or the possibility of showers exists, we will proceed with the hope the weather will clear.

Health & Safety

A nurse will be on-site each day of the program. Allergies (food, plant, insect, etc.) or any notable medical conditions are required information on the registration form.

For any child with known allergies who requires the use of an Epi-Pen, such device will be held by the nurse each day, and returned to the parent upon pick-up.

A "hold harmless" release form will also be required and submitted for each child.

Daily Routine

Each day will include arts & crafts, playground activities, games, and a variety of sports.

A freeze pop treat will be offered at snack time each day. If your child would like to bring additional snacks, feel free to provide. Also, please remember to send a drink (preferably water/juice) for the busy mornings.

The final day will be designated as a Field Day Finale, with age appropriate games and various activities, followed by a picnic of hot dogs, chips, and drinks. Any dessert donations such as cookies or other treats would be greatly appreciated and enjoyed!

Checklist

- Children should wear sneakers and have sunscreen applied each day.
- Please send a white T-shirt or pillowcase for your child on tie-dye day (information regarding the specific day will be provided).
- Since we have an experienced staff and adequate numbers of adults, it would be appreciated if parents would not stay during program hours. Thank you in advance for your consideration and cooperation.
