Attention First Responders!!!

The Town Board is considering a proposed local law regarding a real property tax exemption for volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers pursuant to section 466-A of the real property tax law. There will be a public hearing on April 4th at 6 pm for anyone interested.

What does this mean? All that qualify, would potentially receive up to 10% off their property and school tax bills. Please note, it will not take effect until 2024!

From the Supervisor's Desk



Happy spring to all! Hopefully nice weather arrives soon. I am certain the Highway Department employees would appreciate the break from snow removal. On that note, I want to thank all the employees for the stellar job they do every day but especially during winter in the

great northeast. They certainly rose to the occasion during our March storm where residents reported 20'' - 30'' of snow. They worked tirelessly to maintain our roadways and keep our town residents safe during their travels. Thanks to all for a job well done.

I also want update everyone on a few current events. First and foremost, I would like to welcome Lisa DeGroff to the Town Supervisor's office. Lisa was recently appointed to the position of Confidential Administrator to the supervisor. Lisa brings with her over 30 years of experience in executive office management, human resources and financial oversight. Lisa also brings a wide range of grant writing experience and has been appointed to the position of Westerlo's grant writer. She is currently busy writing two separate grants. One will provide life-saving AEDs for our town buildings and the other is a Hudson River Valley Greenway grant that will cover up to 50% of the cost of the town law update and codification. Lisa is also busy managing the day-to-day operations of the Supervisor's office. Please feel free to stop in and say hello to Lisa.

On another positive note, I would like to report that the town is financially healthy and looking forward to investing in improvements for the town buildings, roadways, parks and expansion of broadband services in 2023. I am proud to report that for the 2023 budget we are able to stay below our 2% tax cap despite an inflation hike of 6.5% in 2022. In order to keep taxes reasonable for the 2023 budget, we managed to cut spending in a few locations and hold to a minimal 1.90% tax increase. Unfortunately, many towns were forced to raise taxes significantly due to unprecedented inflation rates experienced in 2022. Good financial management in Westerlo for fiscal year 2022 made it possible to provide raises to our town employees, pay off debt, invest in new highway equipment, continue improvements to town buildings, roads, and parks, while continuing to grow the towns fund balance. All unused funds from the previous fiscal year get deposited into the fund balance. The only way to grow a fund balance is to maintain operating costs below anticipated budget spending. Fortunately, all town officials and employees do a great job sticking to our budget and finding cost savings wherever possible. I would like to congratulate everyone on a job well done in 2022! Let's continue to be fiscally responsible and attempt to grow our fund balance for 2023.

Why am I so obsessed with building the fund balance? A healthy fund balance is a necessity in uncertain financial times. The benefit to maintaining and building a healthy fund balance is that we will eliminate the possibility of steep tax increases if inflation rates continue to rise. The fund balance can be used to fund or offset portions of the budget to eliminate the need for major tax increases, or the need to exceed the tax cap. In essence, we need to continue to be budget savvy, watch our spending and plan for economic uncertainty in order to not unintentionally overburden the tax payer. If only the state and federal government could grasp these concepts......

On the Road with the Highway Department

Winter certainly ended on a heavy note for the highway department. Unfortunately, one of the Town's trucks was totaled during the big storm that left our Town with 2'-3' of snow (don't worry, the driver is just fine!). With that said, the highway department acted quickly and borrowed a vehicle from the County and powered through to keep up with the heavy snow.

What this now means... In addition to needing to purchase one truck this year, which has been the plan from years past, we are now forced to start thinking about purchasing a second truck. Although costly, these trucks are a necessity but currently very difficult to obtain due to a shortage. Our Highway Superintendent luckily planned ahead and put aside \$200,000 in the 2022 budget and another \$200,000 in this year's budget for just this purpose. The hope is that with the money expected to be received from the claim of the totaled vehicle, we should be able to purchase two trucks without burdening taxpayers. These trucks are essential to maintain roads throughout the year and ultimately receive CHIPS money toward road improvements.

On a happier note, the park ice rink was flooded again for the winter season and was enjoyed by many. The ice rink has just been deconstructed as the highway department is now preparing for spring!

Acceptable forms of payment include: cash, check, money order, credit/debit card. ***Please note: there's a fee for credit/debit cards however, they're NOT accepted for NYS DEC transactions***

- The Town of Westerlo can no longer accept tax payments for the 2023 year. Unpaid bills have since been turned over to Albany County Department of Taxation and Finance. Please reach out to them for the most up-todate account information.
- Just a friendly reminder that every dog in town needs to be licensed
- 2023 Transfer Station permits are required in order to dispose of your waste at the Transfer Station.
 Applications are available at the Town Clerk's office, Transfer Station and online.
- We are sad to report that credit/debit cards fees have increased again for the second time this year. Please keep this in mind when paying with a credit/debit card.
 Unfortunately, the Town has no control over these fees.

News from the Assessor

- A public hearing is scheduled for April 4th at 6 pm for the purpose of discussing proposed Local Law 1 of 2023 regarding providing real property exemptions for volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers pursuant to section 466-A of the real property tax law. Please see the Assessor for more information!
- Any property owner turning 65 years old this year may be eligible for the Enhanced STAR exemption. The March 1st exemption deadline does not apply in some instances. Contact the Assessor for more information!
- The Assessor will continue to drive around town to take pictures of new structures when a Certificate of
 Occupancy has been issued to building permit holders. There will be a Town of Westerlo magnetic sign on the
 side of the vehicle used to accomplish this task. Do not hesitate to contact the Assessor's office if you have any
 questions.
- The Assessor's regular office hours are Thursdays from 4:30 pm to 7 pm however, this does not mean she is not in the office other times. The set hours from 4:30 pm to 7 pm are for the public to come to this office for assistance without an appointment. Please contact the Assessor if you need to make an appointment outside the set hours. Voicemail messages are checked daily and calls will be returned promptly. In most circumstances, calls are returned when the Assessor is in the office so that she can reference information only available at the office.
- The 2023 Tentative Assessment Roll will be filed on or about May 1, 2023. The current roll may be viewed on the Town's website.
- Grievance Day is scheduled for Tuesday, May 23, 2023 from 4 pm to 8 pm in the Assessor's office at the Town Hall.
- Exemption applications received by the March 1st deadline are currently being processed. You will receive notice only if your application is denied.
- Reminder: Can your house #'s be seen? This is very important for emergency services!

Westerlo History

What Happened to the town of Indian Fields?

In the 1920's Albany had the 15th largest reported outbreak of Typhoid in the nation as they used the Hudson River as it's main drinking water source. The Albany Pump Station (now C.H. Evans Brewing Company) still stands as evidence of this! It was then governor Franklin D Roosevelt who approved legislation to allow the city to claim land to build both the Basic and Alcove Reservoirs. Both Reservoirs were created between 1928-1932 and, along with the Loudonville Reservoir, solved Albany's drinking water problem. However, this came at a price.

The surveyor's determined the location based on water sources (Hannacroix Creek and Basic Creek) and reasonable dam locations. Much of the land was farmland or forest, but at the bottom of one of these floodable valleys was the sweet little town of Indian Fields which was technically in Coeymans but bordered Westerlo. It had a post office, a general store run by the Greene's, the Indian Fields Hotel run by the Van Hoesen family, a tea room called the "Bluebird" and a store run by the Simpkins family, a blacksmith shop, a Methodist Church, two mills and even a school. There were about 75 residents and 25 or so buildings.

The City of Albany, through their attorneys, sent letters to each of the property owners in Indian Fields in 1928 that basically stated that they wanted to purchase the land or properties would be condemned and taken from them. The text of an actual letter is as follows:

May 29, 1928

Dear Sir:

The Board of Water Supply of the City of Albany is about to acquire 100.19 acres of your property located near Westerlo, NY for the purpose of maintaining a reservoir to be known as Basic Creek Reservoir. The said Board hereby offers you \$5,000.00 for the above-mentioned number of acres of your land for the above stated purpose. Will you kindly answer this offer on or before the 5th day of June 1928, otherwise the Board will consider the offer rejected and will proceed with condemnation proceedings to acquire the above-mentioned land.

Very truly yours, (Insert Attorney's Name)

Notice that the residents of Indian Fields were given 7 days to respond. The family that received this letter accepted the \$5,000 and moved out by October of that same year. We know of two home owners that actually moved their small homes to Westerlo! One of these houses is still in use and sits directly across the street from the location of the Chesterville Academy north of the Westerlo library! A few residents fought against the demolition of their homes but to no avail.

Once the buildings were vacated some were disassembled to recoup as much money as possible, others were used to house the contractors and workers for the project and then "razed" or burned. Ultimately every building was destroyed and the land was deforested to make way for the new reservoirs.

The total Alcove Reservoir project saw the destruction of 224 buildings and 72 parcels of land which were acquired totaling over 1,500 acres of land that needed to be cleared. Thankfully, the City of Albany took extra care to relocate 14 small cemeteries that were in the flood zone. Each body was exhumed, recorded, families notified and then moved to a large area east of Alcove Reservoir to the newly established "Indian Fields Cemetery" on Waterboard Rd. Such care was taken that even the unmarked graves were exhumed and the City of Albany provided a gravestone listing a letter and a number which can be cross-referenced to one of the 14 cemeteries moved. It's a beautiful little cemetery and might be the only remnant of what was once a sweet little town called "Indian Fields".




