For several months, the Westerlo Hometown Heroes Committee has been working on a permanent tribute for Westerlo veterans. The Committee is happy to report that a tribute and memorial will be installed at the Westerlo Town Park. This project includes the

installation of seven flags; one for each branch of the military and an American flag. Each flagpole will have a solar light fixed to the top of the pole that light up the flags. The project also includes a 10 x 4 x 3 granite tribute and memorial stone that will honor all who have and are currently serving our country in the armed forces. The final touches will include landscaping in and around the area. The project was made possible by donations from Hannay Reels, The Bank of Greene County as well as from residents of Westerlo. Elaine Gruener, COO for Hannay Reels remarked, "I was impressed with the thought and planning that has gone into this worthwhile project for the Town. Hannay Reels will be pleased to make a pledge to make this proposal a reality." The Committee plans a dedication ceremony for the community once the tribute and memorial stone has been installed. In the future, engraved paver stones will line a pathway to the memorial. Pavers will be available for purchase to honor veterans whether or not they are a Westerlo resident. The Committee is grateful for the generosity of Hannay Reels, the Bank of Greene County and the many residents who have supported this project. From the Supervisor's Desk

Hopefully most of you have heard the good news! The House Appropriations
Committee has finally approved the federal spending bill that will provide \$1,687,500.00 in federal grant money to the Town of Westerlo to provide high speed internet access to our residents.



There are many individuals that have spent the last several years working hard to make this dream a reality. First and foremost, this wonderful opportunity would not have been possible without the Westerlo Broadband Research Committee (BRC). These folks are truly the unsung heroes that have worked countless hours behind the scenes to bring this project to fruition. The BRC has never been satisfied that only a portion of our community currently has access to reliable high speed internet. They knew that the Town desperately needed federal funding to be able to continue their work, so they applied for a grant through Congressman Paul Tonko's office to fund Capital Region Community Projects. The BRC and the Supervisor's office spent countless hours developing a broadband implementation plan and preparing a grant application to present to Congressman Paul Tonko. Fortunately for us, our grant application was successful and our project has been given a green light.

Moving forward, we plan to bring reliable high speed internet access to as many households as possible with the funding we have received. Hopefully this translates to at least the majority of Westerlo residents. We will continue to fight for the funding required to provide reliable high speed internet to all Westerlo residents in the near future. Thank you to everyone who has helped make this dream a reality.

A Full Town Board and a Full Zoning Board of Appeals

At the Tuesday March 15th Town Board meeting, Board Members voted unanimously to appoint Peter Mahan to fill the vacancy on the Town Board. The vacancy was created when Matt Kryzak was elected as Town Supervisor. As Supervisor, the seat Matt held as a Town Board Member became vacant. Mr. Mahan brings a lifetime of municipal experience and Board Member experience. Some items from his resume include past positions as a Lieutenant with the Albany Fire Department, EMT with Albany Fire Department, Detective with the Coeymans Police Department, Chief of Police in New Baltimore and small business owner with his own auto garage. He has served as a Board Member for the Albany Fire Department Union and worked together with the Town of Baltimore Board as Police Chief. At the same Town Board meeting, members also voted unanimously to appoint Rich Van Iderstsine to fill a vacancy on the Zoning Board of Appeals.

News from the Assessor

- Please be advised that the Assessor will continue to drive around town to take pictures of new structures when a Certificate of Occupancy has been issued to building permit holders. There will be a Town of Westerlo magnetic sign on the side of the vehicle used to accomplish this task. Do not hesitate to contact the Assessor's office if you have any questions.
- The Assessor's regular office hours are Thursdays from 4:30 to 7 pm however, this does not mean she is not in the office other times. The set hours from 4:30 to 7 pm are for the public to come to this office for assistance without an appointment. Please contact the Assessor if you need to make an appointment outside the set hours. Voicemail messages are checked daily and calls will be returned promptly. In most circumstances, calls are returned when the Assessor is in the office so that she can reference information only available at the office.
- The 2022 Tentative Roll will be completed and filed on May 1, 2022.
- The 2022 Board of Assessment Review is scheduled for Wednesday, May 25, 2022 from 4 pm – 8 pm. Complaint on Real Property Assessment forms (RP-524) are available in the Assessor's office or at tax.ny.gov/forms.
- There are two guides available to resident property owners. They are entitled "Understanding the Equalization Rate" and "Fair Assessments". If you are interested in either, or both, please contact the Assessor's office or stop at the Town Hall where copies are available.

Town Clerk's Corner

Fishing, hunting and marriage licenses may be obtained at the office of the Town Clerk, 933 County Route 401. The Town Clerk's office also issues dog licenses, parking permits for persons with disabilities, Certificates of Residence, transfer station permits (residents only), birth/death/marriage certificates and copies of vital records. They can also assist with genealogy searches, Freedom of Information (FOIL) requests as well as free notary services. Acceptable forms of payment include: cash, check, money order, credit/debit card. ***Please note: credit/debit cards are NOT accepted for NYS DEC transactions***

On the Road with the Highway Department



The Highway Superintendent Jody Ostrander and the employees of Westerlo Highway Department have been busy keeping the town roads cleared during winter's uniquely unsettled weather. Blizzards, rain, sleet, floods, windstorms, downed trees and even thunderstorms have become the norm. Some storms provided all the above weather features in less than 24 hours. No matter what mother nature has thrown our way, the Highway Department has managed to keep our roads in good shape. Maintaining the roads and providing safe passage



requires having the right piece of equipment for the job which is something that Jody has been focusing on during his current term in office. In recent months, he has put an emphasis on updating the Highway Department's equipment, focusing on advanced safety features that protect the equipment operator. He most recently acquired a new loader and pickup truck by selling outdated equipment, saving tax payers thousands in the process.

Most importantly, Jody has worked hard in recent months to create a "safety culture" among the Town highway employees that will help maintain a safe work environment for all. This "safety culture" prevents accidents and ensures that everyone gets to go home safe at the end of the day.

And if that weren't enough to keep the Highway Department busy, Jody and his staff successfully brought back the ice-skating rink to the Town Park. This much loved benefit of yesteryear was enjoyed by many. The Highway crew constantly monitored the condition of the rink for safety and enjoyment. Next year's rink is expected to be new and improved.

The cemetery volunteers work hard to keep the cemetery looking neat and clean and often receive very nice compliments. This is back breaking work, any help residents can provide would be appreciated. Many hands make light work!

RESTORING AND REBUILDING

Steve, the cemetery caretaker, has been slowly working on rebuilding collapsed stones. Stones are owned by the families of the deceased, those families are responsible for their upkeep. When volunteers do not know the owner of a stone or cannot contact the family of the deceased, they work on the fallen stones to restore them. Proceeds from the snack sales of the Halloween Trunk or Treat help fund this project.
